**1. Background**

As part of the E.U and PAP4 grant towards a participative, inclusive, and sustainable management of the Forest landscape complex of Outamba-Kilimi (Sierra Leone), Kuru Hills (Sierra Leone), and Pinselli-Soya (Guinea), an activity will be carried out in line with Output 1: OKKPS Land use planning - to establish environmental, territorial, socio-economic and anthropological baseline assessments in communities in and around the National Park . The OKNP is considered a priority area for conservation due to its high density of flagship and endangered species such as the critically endangered Western Chimpanzee, elephant, pangolin, lion, leopard and hippopotamus among many others and also the rosewood (therocapous spp) which has been logged illegally witin the park over the years. The aim of this activity is to assess the needs of households in communities in and around the National Park inother to provide the right livelihood intervention to these households as a way of preventing human activities (hunting and illegal logging ) in the National park.

The consultant is expected to analyse and write the final report of the field mission for the socioeconomic activities, this will involve data analysis collected in the field and giving suggestions of possible livelihood interventions for each one of the communities surveyed.

The main objective of this Consultancy is to provide a service leading to the analysis of data and final report writing of the SEA.

- To analyze all socio-economic data collected on the Kobo Tool
- Clean the raw data of the socio-economic information collected and provide a summary data table with the relevant information

  - Proposed possible education interventions
- Generate potential list of household beneficiaries with key selection criteria and intervention communities
